

The first two books were quite good. This third installment stalls, and does not contain the story arcs that were interesting in the first two. OK - what is lacking is the little focus on levelling up and the over focus on actual battle scenes. There are too many and they are too long. After reading a few, I ended up skimming the battle scenes because they are filler. Feels like the author extended the battle scenes because he couldn't advance the story itself. The first two books focused on character building, and character rivalries, and videos. Book three goes away from that focus. It also introduces too many named characters, but with no back story, they end up being just flat, two

dimensional and meaningless to the reader. The author introduces something like 30 or 40 character names, but without a back story, it's a pointless diversion of attention. He had started with a theme of three different adventurers levelling up in different ways and in different parts of the world. The natural extension would have been to write subsequent books from each of the three points of view either as one book each or three parts of one book. Rather, there is a pathetically developed love story between the main character and Sierra. There is a Point of view from Sierra which is okay, as she desires independence and has her own character development.
