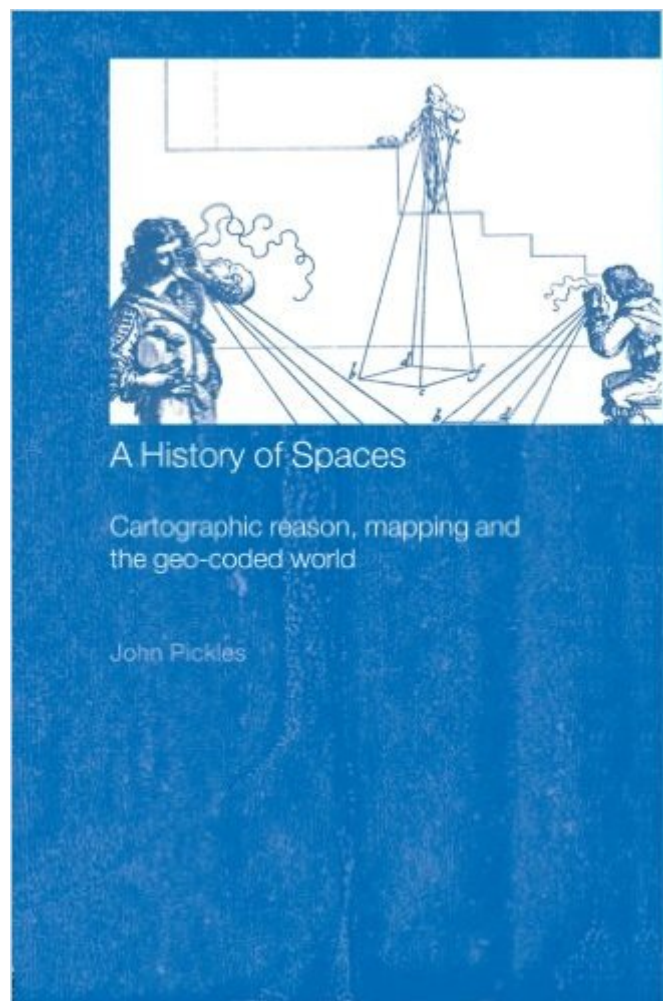

Synopsis

This book provides an essential insight into the practices and ideas of maps and map-making.
