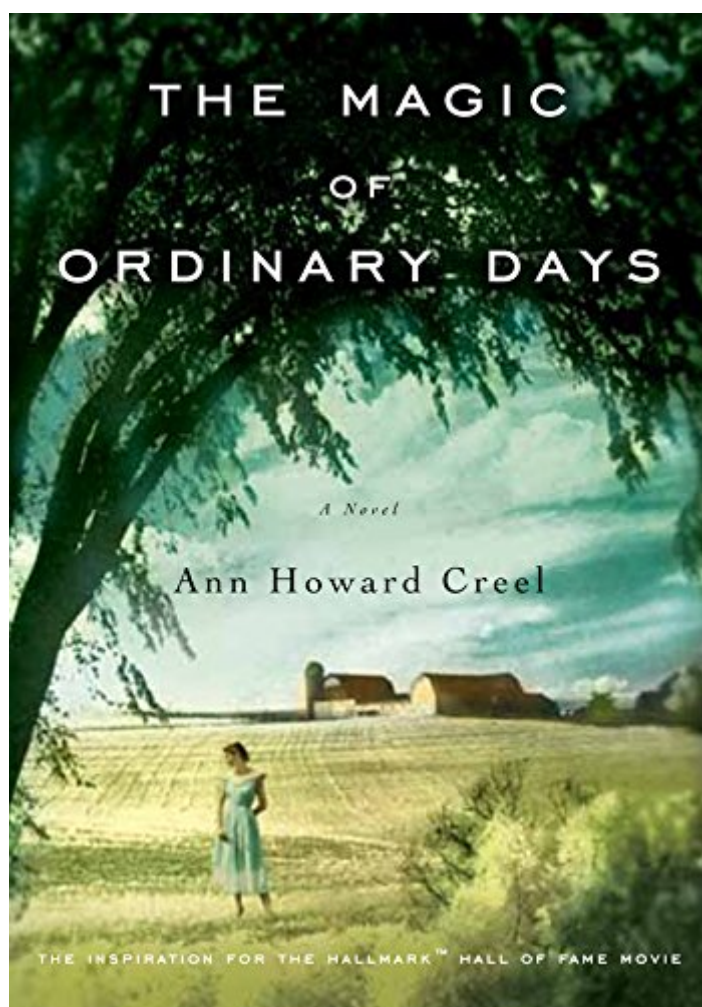

At first glance THE MAGIC OF ORDINARY DAYS is a love story. Of the surface it relates the story of Livvy, who is pregnant and forced to marry a man that she does not know. The story focuses on the evolution of their relationship and the changes in Livvy's life. Her husband Ray, has the very appropriate last name of Singleton, because he is indeed a single, solitary man. But on a broader scale, there are a number of underlying themes that the reader should be aware of. The first is the

responsibility that people must take for their own acts and how what seem to be casual decisions about relationships can alter a person's life. Issues of family relationships are also brought out in the book. Most people will identify in some way with the relationships between the siblings. Women will contemplate what they would have done had they been Livvy - pregnant and without a husband in the early 1940's - and how their own father would have reacted. The underlying issues of religion and a small community vs a large city are also present. Author Ann Howard Creel masterfully deals with a subject that is popular among historians and this is women on the home front during the time of war. She also deals with men, such as Ray who does not go to war but still deals with issues of guilt. Creel's handling of the issues of Japanese interment is excellent. It is a subject that many readers, especially young readers will know little about. So her even handed descriptions are informative. In addition, most Americans have little knowledge of the German and Italian POW's that came to America. The Hallmark Hall of Fame did a wonderful job with this novel, following almost exactly as Creel wrote it, although she did not use the first person.
