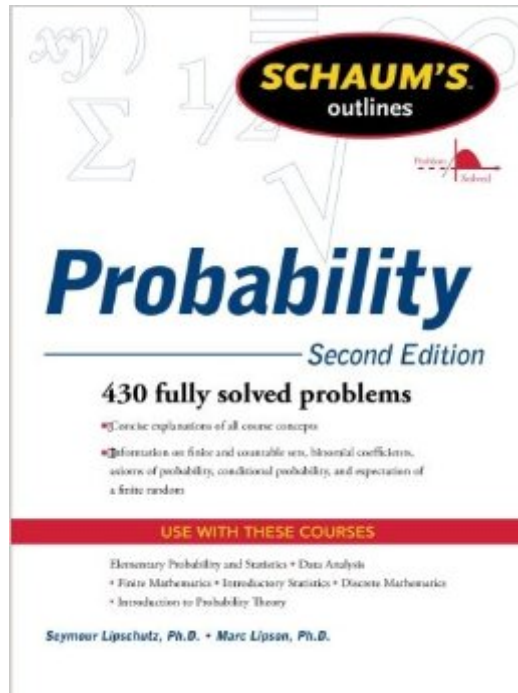

I am using this book to study for the Mathematics CSET subtest 2 exam which covers Probability/Statistics and Geometry. This book has been VERY useful because of the numerous solved problems and the way that detailed solutions and methodology are provided for attacking, understanding and ultimately solving various types of problems. The only caveat is that there are A LOT of typos and mistakes in the book. This is disheartening as ideally this book would be a

bullet-proof way to check one's work, progress and own understanding of the topic. I would feel more assured if there were a higher level of accuracy. I suppose I am progressing in my comprehension and competence in this subject matter as I am now able to reason what solutions and methodologies should be (enabling me to recognize the mistakes in the book). This is happening as I am working through the problems a second time to ensure my ability. My enhanced skills are due solely due to this book as it has been the best resource I have found so far. However I continue to find a significant number of mistakes within the book as I go deeper into it. Just be aware.

Typos seem to be par for the course in math exercise books. I have yet to find a single one that doesn't have more than a typo per page. That gets extremely frustrating when the material gets harder. This one has about two or three typos per page if you're generous in your definition of "typo." Still, the material is well-rounded enough.

On page 5, figure 1-3 (a), the intersection of A and B should be also shaded. I don't know whether this is a printed mistake or the book has some errors. And I haven't been able to find the errata of this book. This book is good, however, I really need to see the errata!!!

I like doing math puzzles. I am in my stats/probabilities phase now. I have a lot of Schaum's books and they're all pretty good. I like that there are plenty of problems to work. I agree about the errors but they keep you 'on your toes.' Don't assume. I purchased this from Amazon but it doesn't appear as a Verified Purchase. I seem to have that problem with several Kindle books and I'm not sure why. I purchased it over two years ago and I used the link. Only 300ish more book reviews to go! Works well on both of my Kindles and on my Chromebook Cloud Reader. 5 stars.

I'm taking a graduate course in probability. This book is really a life saver. It describes the essence of what you need to know. The author is not trying to be fancy or show off. There are some mistakes. That is why I give it 4 stars. But well worth the money.

The book has a lot of errors. Errors don't help when you are trying to learn a subject.
