He's escaping from prison, but it's OK because he was unjustly convicted. The heroine is beautiful and her mother and boyfriend don't value her enough. "Sexual tension" crops up right away. And on and on and on. If you enjoy almost every romance, this is probably the book for you. If you were looking for suspense, try something else.
