

On April 28, 1999, on a lonely Arkansas highway, a wreck claimed the life of a young man who was bound for glory in the NFL. Brandon Burlsworth, widely considered the greatest walk-on in the history of college football, was a man of hard work, integrity, and commitment, who took no short cuts in life. This was a guy who did everything "right", only to see all of it snatched away right before he could enjoy the fruits of his hard work. With everything appearing to fall into place for Brandon, we are left with wondering: why? "Through the Eyes of a Champion" has as its goal a reasonable answer to the "why", along with the pure joy of celebrating a magnificent life.
