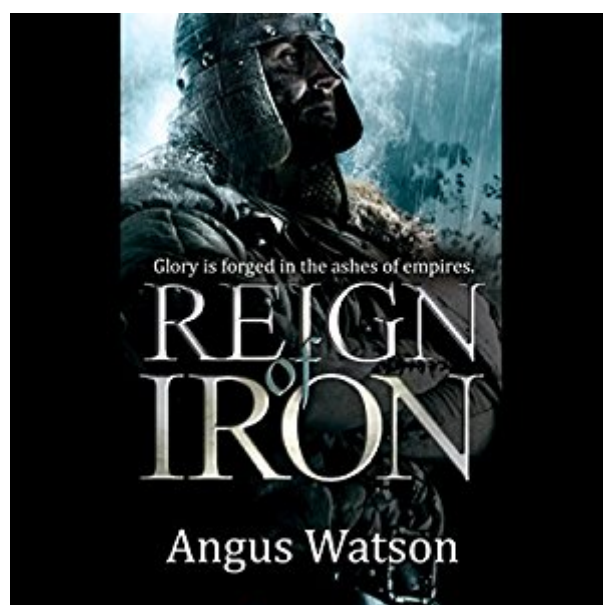

Watson's 3rd and final book in the Iron Age trilogy ends with a solid bang. Although ALL 3 books are good, this last one was better than the 2nd one. If you like historical fantasy, then you should really enjoy this trilogy. If you are squeamish about sex and violence, then look elsewhere. My husband and I both very much liked Watson's trilogy. Very much along the lines as Joe Abercrombie with its very dark edge of mixing historical elements along with magical elements to make a character-driven story with modern-thinking and speaking ass-kicking characters and plot just jump out of the page. Angus Watson has his own unique voice, and it reminded us strongly of the old-timer pulps that wrote back in the 30's through the 70's, from Conan the Barbarian to The Gray Mouser type fantasy action pulp era adventure stars. Have to say that author Watson is neither dull or boring in his 500+-pages novel, and that is saying something! We gave the first two books to a

male friend who is also loving these books, so that is yet another stamp of approval. I think it was in Watson's first book, in the back, where the author wrote something along the lines of what his next novel was going to be. Something along the lines of a caveman type setting, along with dinosaurs. Hope this is true! Not enough of those type of books in the sci-fi/fantasy genre. We think he would do something akin to that very well.

The most underrated book I have read this year. I did not buy the book through so when I came on here to see what everyone else thought of this series I was surprised to see only two reviews. If you like Abercrombie you will like this. No this is not a cheap knockoff of the First Law series. Iron Age does have a very similar brutal humor that The First Law has and the main character is similar but that's it. This series has great characters, the humor is LOL at some points, The history is interesting (you can tell the writer knows his stuff). This series needs more buzz so buy it! Now!

I reserve 5 stars for my favorites and an author I would pick up again and again. Angus Watson has an easy writing style, entertaining and intriguing characters and plenty of action. I have seen other reviewers compare to Cornwell and while I think that is high praise, this is definitely a fantasy series, based upon some indirect non-fiction. Not quite Sanderson, not quite Cornwell, it is something unique to Watson and done very, very well.
