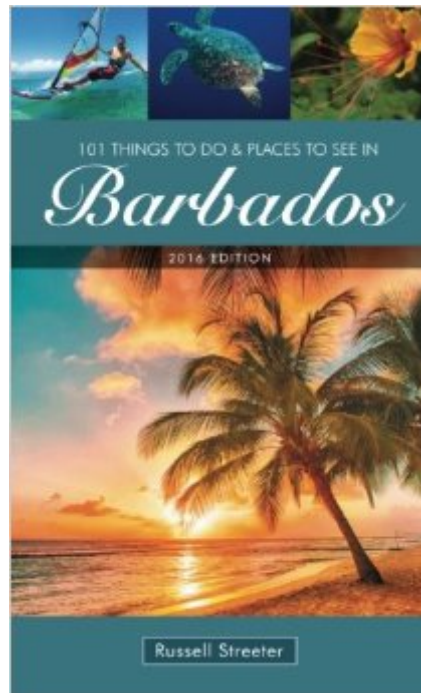

This book starts with brief history of the island - great for context - and then lists beaches, attractions and activities with useful descriptions including the personal experience of the author. I lived in Barbados for a few years in childhood and will be returning with my family for a visit this year. This book is a great refresher but also a good resource for the first-time visitor.
