

One never stops learning in the sport of driving dogs and I can recommend this book to both novice and experienced skijorers alike. I personally know and admire both of the authors for their skill with, and innate understanding of sled dogs. I referred to the 1st edition of "Skijor with Your Dog" when I started skijoring and later was mentored by Mari Hoe-Raitto, which gave me the basis to developed a champion sprint sled dog team. Great new edition, with terrific information about the sport. Written by experts in the field, and a well respected professional dog writer, this resource will get you and your dog started in a fun winter past time. I had a couple small nits/concerns with information that may not have been updated from the first edition. "Alpha roll" to teach a dog the human is in charge is not recommended (and in fact is not emphasized in the book, either--but is mentioned). Further, while many sled dogs are tethered as a means to keep them safe from wandering, that's not a technique recommended for pet dogs and may in fact be illegal so check your local ordinances. I loved the photos and the great illustrations that demonstrated equipment. This is an exhaustive book that will appeal to people curious out the sport as well as more experienced dog sports folks. The publisher provided me with a review copy of the book for an honest and unbiased review.
