

Over the course of the 1980s, the NCAA basketball tournament progressed from being somewhat popular to being one of the premier events of the national sports calendar and a rite of spring. It certainly didn't hurt that seven of the eight championship games from 1982 to 1989 were classics that were not decided until the final minute. The 1985 title game in which the Villanova Wildcats dethroned the mighty Georgetown Hoyas was the most compelling of the decade and is the subject of Frank Fitzpatrick's "The Perfect Game."Heading into the 1984-85 season Georgetown was widely expected to repeat as national champion and the Big East, the conference in which Georgetown and Villanova played, was the strongest in the country in the latter half of the 1980s. Fitzpatrick provides brief histories of the two universities and biographical sketches of Villanova coach Rollie Massimino and Georgetown coach John Thompson, and also tells the story of how both squads were assembled. Georgetown was a polarizing team in the mid-Eighties--it was ardently supported by many blacks and despised by many whites, and Fitzpatrick recalls some of the uply racial slurs that center Patrick Ewing had to endure during his career (the book has one glaring blight, though, in that the author then goes on to imply absurdly that the Reagan administration was hostile to blacks). Fitzpatrick leads the reader through the season for both teams and remembers how each made it to the Final Four in Lexington.
