


Measuring Behaviour: An Introductory Guide

Aimed primarily at undergraduate and graduate students in biology and psychology who are about to embark upon quantitative studies of animal and human behaviour, this book provides a concise review of methodology that will be of great value to scientists of all disciplines in which behaviour is measured, including biological anthropology, the social sciences and medicine.

This is a fantastic book for anyone interested in the study of human or non-human behavior in lab or field settings. The authors pack nothing but the vital basics in this guide. They cover topics such as research design (sample sizes) and data analysis (parametric vs. nonparametric stats). Reading this book is a great use of your time if you're considering research on animal behavior.

This book is a perfect introduction to the field of behavioral data collection. I purchased this book for

my first behavioral study of captive primates and it was extremely helpful. If you have never conducted research in this area, this book is a must have.

I am a fourth-year undergrad doing research with birds. This is a great starter text to use for a quick overview of all aspects of research techniques. Not so detailed that its daunting to read, but covers all the basics to keep in mind when designing and conducting research projects. A good reference to keep close at hand.
