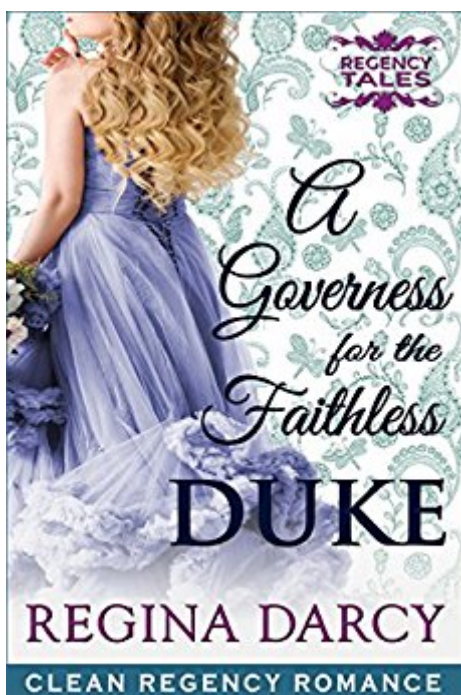

The Duke has a reputation as a heartless rake, having left two women standing at the altar. Charlotte has her work cut out for her with Emily and Mary Anne, the spoiled nieces. However, she uses her own methods to gain their cooperation and they begin to make satisfactory progress. Meanwhile, Charlotte and the Duke develop a mutual respect and love that each tries to dismiss and avoid. If I had proofread this book, I would have corrected 8 errors. I only deduct a star from my rating if there are more than 10 errors.

This was a sweet story of a young woman with no expectations and two lonely children who needed her. Sadly, the story has no hitches and it resembles a fairy tale of everyone of the characters are perfectly decent people. It was almost too sweet and actually geared to be read by young ladies who have no concept of adventure. I enjoyed the innocence and the fairy tale aspect, but would recommend it for a younger audience.

Utterly unoriginal and sadly lacking in imagination, this book was a disappointment. Remedial sentence structure and a mortifying misuse of commas created a stilted flow. The time period of the story was not reinforced with suitable vocabulary and the characters were likewise underdeveloped. The storyline was boorish, overly simple, and lacked enough embellishment to stay interesting.
